

 - Date Of Bootcamp : 21st and 22nd May 2024 (2 days) tentatively.
2. Period of Bootcamp : 2 hours per day for a student. Maximum two batches per selected schools.
 3. Venue: The Bootcamp will be conducted in at least 2 schools per Taluka.
 4. Participants: Students of class V, VI, VII, VIII of AY 2023-24, of all schools across the state of Goa, including schools other than Goa State Board.
 5. Mode of Conduct: Offline (In Person mode)
 6. Batch Schedule : Batch I - 9.00 am to 11.00 am , Batch II - 11.30 am to 1.30 pm

Limited Seats available. Enrollment will be based on a first come first serve basis.
Selected students will be notified on www.cares.goa.gov.in.
