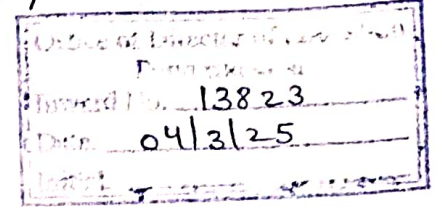

Subject: Information regarding enrollment process for the Class VI, Class VII and Class VIII Revised ICT Elective curriculum of AY 2025-26

Sir,

The PMU has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing Coding and Robotics classes under the Coding and Robotics Education in Schools (CARES) scheme, aiming to incorporate computational and design thinking abilities, along with programming, into school-level teaching in Goa.

For the upcoming academic year 2025-26, 162 Lead Schools from AY 2024-25 are confirmed as locations for the elective curriculum delivery for which the ICT labs have been upgraded providing 12 Robotic Hardware kits and Teach for Goa Fellow to teach the curriculum.

At the 10th Executive Committee meeting- CARES additional 34 Govt./Govt. Aided schools are accepted towards becoming Lead Schools for AY 2025-26 with necessary ICT lab upgradation post Government approval.

PMU will be conducting Class VI, Class VII and Class VIII Revised ICT Elective curriculum for the upcoming AY 2025-26 across the state in approximately 200 Lead schools, catering to 15000+ students.

For the upcoming academic year 2025-26, the eligibility for Revised ICT Elective curriculum is stated below:

SR NO	Elective Curriculum of Class	Classes Eligible from Govt. and Govt. Aided Schools
1.	Class VI	Outgoing Std. V Students of AY 2024-2025
2.	Class VII	Outgoing Std. VI Students of AY 2024-2025
3.	Class VIII	Outgoing Std. VII Students of AY 2024-2025 *Outgoing Std. VIII Students of AY 2024-2025 maybe allowed conditionally.

The Enrollment Process Period for enrolling eligible students for the Revised ICT Elective will be open on PRERNA portal (<https://cares.goa.gov.in/prerna/login/>) from 03rd March 2025 to 05th April 2025.
