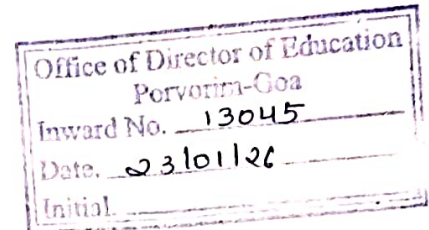

**Subject: Towards Jagrucktay Sessions for Awareness of ICT Elective Curriculum for AY 2026-27**

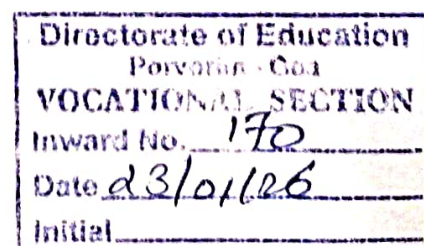
Sir,

The Project Management Unit (PMU) under the Coding and Robotics Education in Schools (CARES) Scheme is presently delivering the Revised ICT Elective Curriculum for Classes VI, VII, and VIII across 209 Lead Schools, benefiting more than 18,000 students during the ongoing Academic Year 2025-26. It aims to strengthen computational thinking, design thinking, and programming skills among students of Government and Government-Aided Schools in Goa.

For the upcoming Academic Year 2026-27, the PMU will continue to deliver the Class VI, VII, and VIII Elective Curriculum, wherein students currently studying in Std. 5, 6 and 7 during AY 2025-26 will be eligible:
